Supervisor of Elections Statement on the Broward County Mask Ordinance

I commend the hundreds of thousands of voters who have participated in two countywide elections in 2020 and particularly those who complied with the Broward County ordinance pertaining to the wearing of masks in buildings open to the public. On behalf of our staff and thousands of pollworkers, Thank You.

This ordinance remains in effect through Election Day. Broward County intends to enforce the ordinance and seek all remedies against violators as provided by the ordinance.

For your continued safety at all polling locations, this office will require safe social distancing and ensure that all poll workers will be properly gloved, masked and otherwise adhere to all public health guidance. Voters who are not masked on arrival at a polling place will be strongly encouraged to wear a mask and reminded of the ordinance. For those who do not have a mask, one will be provided at no charge.

Finally, each polling place on Election Day and early voting has an assigned janitor who will work to maintain hygiene standards under every circumstance.

Broward County election professionals appreciate your continued cooperation during this challenging time. All of us will do what needs to be done to provide a safe election for all of Broward County's voters, produce accurate, timely election results.
