

## Special Israel Update



To Our Broward County Community,

The Jewish Federation of Broward County stands in total solidarity with Israel and the IDF as they defend themselves from this unprecedented attack by The Islamic Republic of Iran.

This is the first time since the Gulf War in 1991 that a sovereign nation directly attacked Israel. Over 331 missiles and drones were launched at the Jewish state. In what is being described as a remarkable military success, an international coalition led by the US military, combined with Israel's multi-layered and technologically sophisticated aerial defense systems, intercepted 99% of the arsenal fired, resulting in only one major injury.

We continue to pray for Israel's safety and are thankful that the United States and our allies are standing strong with Israel and helping to defend her against the Iranian threat.

Here in Broward County, our Federation remains vigilant and in regular contact with local law enforcement to ensure our Jewish organizations remain open, fully operational, and secure.
