That work is only possible thanks to community stakeholders who generously give their time, talent, and resources to ensure we may continue to strengthen and build our flourishing Jewish community.

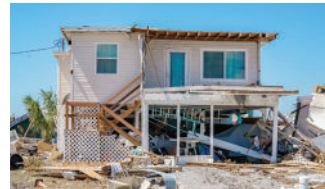

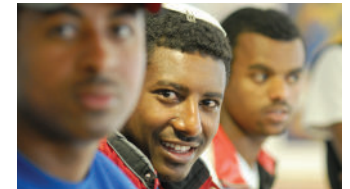
Strengthening Jewish Identity by ensuring that Jews of all ages can experience and explore their connection to Jewish history, Jewish tradition, and Jewish community.
