Mr. Tinter was born in Brooklyn, NY in 1947. With over 48 years of service providing professional transportation expertise to both private and public clients, he retired in 2017. His experience included employment with public agencies (local and state), as well as a number of private traffic engineering consultants in both Connecticut and Florida, including 22 years as President and Owner of Tinter Associates, Inc. Services included the preparation of parking and traffic studies; transportation-related concurrency evaluations; transportation evaluations of Land Use Plan Amendments; traffic, circulation and parking analyses in conjunction with Eminent Domain proceedings; transportation considerations in litigations related to accidents or land use issues; and the completion of traffic engineering plans, such as signalization, lighting, channelization, pavement marking and signing plans. He has provided Expert Witness testimony to clients to present findings to governmental agencies, including Planning and Zoning Boards, City Commissions, County Commissions, Administrative Hearings, Courts and other regulatory bodies. From 2017 to 2000, Mr. Tinter was a member of the Planning & Zoning Board for the City of Ft. Lauderdale.

Mr. Tinter, who had previously been a member of the Board of Directors of the Jewish Federation of Broward County, rejoined that Board of Directors in May 2024. As a member of the Board of the JFBC, he currently serves on a number of committees that support the agency.
