is a trauma-informed treatment program for adults 60+. Treatment activities are individualized with the latest innovations in wellness to empower participants.



Mrs. Z is an 86-year-old Holocaust Survivor who walks without

assistance, goes to the gym daily, and takes no prescription drugs. Due to childhood trauma, Mrs. Z has difficulty with time alone and isolation. In her Silver CARE sessions, Mrs. Z receives therapy, nutritional supplements, and breathing practices. This support helps her process her trauma so she can lead a happy life.
