PJ Library is a donor-supported program for families with kids ages 0-12 and at least one member who identifies as Jewish. PJ Library provides children from birth to age eight with free storybooks and activities that spark conversations about the diversity of the Jewish experience and inspire the whole family to celebrate what they love about their Judaism. Older readers, ages nine to 12, get to pick their own title from a selection of middle-grade books.
