Free Training Available to Members of Our Broward Jewish Community

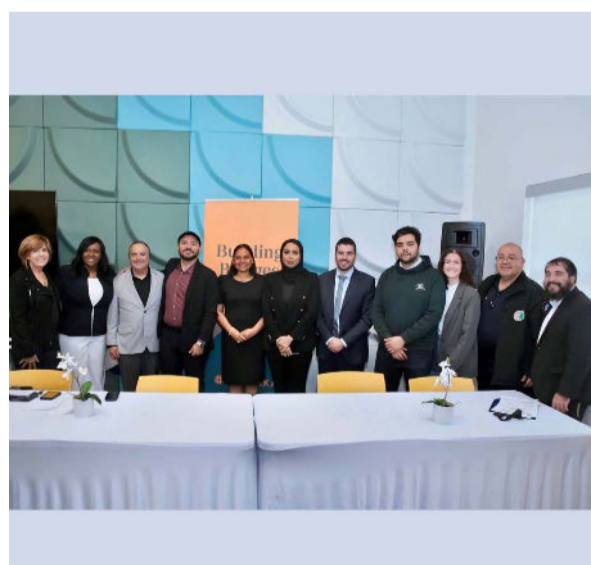
