Partnership with Secure Community Network (SCN)

Threat and Vulnerability Risk Assessments: Evaluations to identify potential security vulnerabilities while providing a roadmap for mitigating the identified security gaps.

Incident Reporting Platform: A streamlined process for reporting security incidents, ensuring timely and effective dissemination to the appropriate entity for resolution.

Tabletop Exercises: Interactive sessions to simulate potential scenarios and refine response strategies, enhancing your preparedness for real-life situations.

Free Security Equipment Available

Facility Security Enhancements: Deployable security resources, including weapon detection systems, are available to strengthen security measures, deter potential threats at high-traffic events and entry points, support proactive risk identification, and add a visible layer of protection.

Crowd and Vehicle Control Solutions: Traffic control equipment, including barricades, cones and signs, is available to support safe, organized environments during events and daily operations by assisting with effective crowd management and vehicle access control, reducing risk and maintaining orderly flow.

Emergency Response Preparedness: Life-saving medical products, including bleeding control kits, are available to support immediate response during critical incidents by enabling rapid intervention and stabilization prior to the arrival of definitive health care.

Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) Support

Navigating the FEMA Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) can be complex and challenging, but we are here to assist. We provide support in the following ways:

Grant Specialist: A dedicated professional will be available to guide you through the stages of the grant process. This pilot program is designed to support you during the grant-writing phase and in managing your grant progress post-approval.

Application assistance: We can provide risk assessments for your property, as well as additional resources for the grant application process, helping you align with grant requirements.
